ART AL SOL

“Art al Sol” is an exciting five day visual arts summer camp for students interested in creating art. Students will explore drawing, painting, mixed media and sculptural aspects of art. Discover, create and produce art with friends in a lively, fun and art-filled environment! At 2:00 p.m. on the final day of each session, students will share their creations at a reception for family and friends. Students should be self-motivated and plan to attend all five days of the session.

This program is best for students who are self-disciplined and have the ability to work independently. If the instructors find a student lacks the maturity to handle the camp schedule of activities, the student’s parents will be asked to withdraw the student. Fees are non-refundable.

Final deadline for application and payment is May 1, 2017 or until all spaces are filled.

Due to the limited enrollment of 25 students per session, spaces will be assigned the day the completed application, medical form and deposit are received at the district office. Forms and payment can be mailed to the address listed on the Medical Release Form or delivered in person to Customer Service at the district office located at 2601 Bransford Ave; Nashville, TN 37204. Customer Service is located at the Berry Road entrance.
